CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this body shall be Clear Creek Baptist Association.

ARTICLE II - AFFILIATION

The Association shall affiliate with the Illinois Baptist State Association, the Southern Baptist Convention and the Canadian National Baptist Convention.

ARTICLE III - ARTICLES OF FAITH

The Association shall subscribe to the *Baptist Faith and Message* adopted by the Southern Baptist Convention on June 14, 2000.

ARTICLE IV - MISSION

The Mission of Clear Creek Baptist Association is encouraging churches toward effectively fulfilling the Great Commission, equipping Christian leaders, and inspiring cooperation among God's people.

ARTICLE V - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. The Association is composed of Baptist Churches who wish to cooperate in carrying out the Mission of the Association and are in harmony with the purpose and spirit of the *Baptist Faith and Message*. Member churches shall annually submit Church Profile reports to the Association. Member churches shall contribute financial support to the Association each year. Member churches are encouraged to be represented by Messengers to the Annual Meeting and membership in the Executive Board.

Section 2. Membership in the Association shall be purely voluntary. The Association shall not exercise any authority over the churches in respect to their doctrines or method of work; but may exercise the right to counsel and advise any church that appears to have departed from the faith and practice of the New Testament, and to withdraw fellowship from any church and refuse to recognize messengers from such church that might vary fundamentally from the teachings of the *Baptist Faith and Message*.

ARTICLE VI - ANNUAL MEETING

Section 1. The Association shall meet annually in October on the date and place established by action of the Association at the previous year's meeting.

Section 2. Messengers to the Annual Meeting shall be the senior Pastors of member churches, their elected Board members, and three Messengers elected by each church. Other Messengers shall include elected Associational Officers, Committee Chairmen, and the Acts 1:8 Team. Each Messenger shall have one vote.

ARTICLE VII - THE BOARD

The Association shall have a Board made up of leaders of the Association charged with responsibility of carrying on the business of the Association during the interim between Annual Meetings.

ARTICLE VIII - PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE

Parliamentary proceedings of the Association shall be guided by *Robert's Rules of Order*, latest revision.

ARTICLE IX - OFFICERS

The Officers of the Association shall be Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, Assistant Clerk, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, and Trustees. The Executive Director shall be an *ex officio* Officer of the Association serving as the primary executive and administrative officer. This function shall be performed in consultation with the Moderator and the Board. All shall be members of churches affiliated with the Association.

ARTICLE X - ORGANIZATION

Section 1. To fulfill its mission and assist member churches effectively, the Association shall provide organizational leaders. Leaders will provide motivation and training by promoting and publicizing all associational, state, and denominational meetings, activities, and projects. Leaders may enlist others to assist them in accomplishing their work. Leaders may include an Acts 1:8 Team—Local, Illinois, North America, International and other offices as may be deemed needed by the Association or the Board.

Section 2. Active committees are essential to the effective functioning of the Association. The Association currently has three standing committees: Personnel, Stewardship and Trustees. Other committees may be added or those no longer serving a purpose may be deleted by action of the Association or the Board.

ARTICLE XI - AMENDMENTS

All proposed amendments to the Constitution shall be submitted in writing to the Trustees. Recommended amendments shall be presented at two consecutive annual meetings, the first for reading only, and the second for discussion and vote. A two-thirds majority of the messengers voting is required to amend the Constitution.

BY-LAWS OF THE CONSTITUTION

These By-laws of the Constitution are designed to assist the leaders in carrying out their responsibilities in directing the internal affairs of the Association. They apply to the various Articles of the Constitution needing such procedural guidelines. The Sections are in the same sequence and the headings coincide with the Articles of the same name.

SECTION A - MEMBERSHIP

1. A church seeking membership in the Association shall forward a petitionary letter to the Trustees at least sixty days before the Annual Meeting of the Association. Attached to the letter should be the Church's Annual Church Profile form completed for a twelve-month period, a copy of the Articles of Faith, and a copy of the Church's Constitution & By-laws adopted by the Church.

2. The Trustees shall review the request and make any further investigation they deem necessary or desirable. Based on their findings, the Trustees shall make a recommendation to the Association during a business session of the Annual Meeting. A three-fourths majority of the messengers voting shall be required for admission.

3. If a church fails to file an Annual Church Profile form for three consecutive years, it shall be considered as having withdrawn from the Association. If a church fails to submit financial support for three consecutive years, it shall be considered as having withdrawn from the Association. Upon a vote of the Executive Board at Annual Meeting, the church will be dropped from membership.

4. In the event any member church in practice appears to violate the Articles of Faith adopted by the Association, the Trustees will investigate. If a violation is found, an attempt will be made to bring about reconciliation. Failing in this, the Trustees will make appropriate recommendations to the Association during its Annual Meeting. Withdrawal of fellowship will require a two-thirds majority of the messengers voting.

SECTION B - THE BOARD

1. The Board shall be called the Executive Board and shall be composed of the senior Pastors of member churches, one elected Executive Board Member from each church, the Associational Moderator and all Associational Officers, Acts 1:8 Team Leaders, and standing Committee Chairmen along with the Executive Director and regular staff members.

2. The Executive Board is responsible for the work of the Association during the interim between Annual Meetings. They shall meet quarterly starting with January. The regular dates shall be established by the Associational Calendar after approval at the Annual Meeting. The Moderator may call a special meeting by notifying all members of the Executive Board at least a week before the meeting date. Fifteen members will be required for a quorum to conduct business. The Board shall present a full report to the Association during the Annual Meeting.

3. The Executive Board shall also be responsible for employing the Executive Director and other staff members, establishing terms of employment, and termination of their services. In the event the Executive Director position is vacant, the Board shall elect a special Search Committee of seven members selected from the Executive Board. This committee shall be comprised of individuals from seven different churches, and include at least one female member, as well as one layperson. Working with the Executive Board, they shall establish desired criteria. They shall then seek candidates, interview, and make recommendations to the Executive Board.

4. Executive Board Members elected to represent affiliated churches should keep their respective churches informed of actions and goals of the Board. In the event a member church loses representation through resignation or death, a new Board Member should be elected to fill the vacancy.

SECTION C - OFFICERS

Except for filling vacancies, all officers shall be elected during the Annual Meeting after nominations are made by the Trustees. A majority vote of messengers voting is required for election. Each officer of the Association shall deliver all items that pertain to his office to his successor upon completion of his duties. *

* Where masculine gender is used, it is considered as generic and may apply to male or female members.

The following duties, terms of office, and method of election apply to the officers indicated:

1. The **Moderator** shall preside over the Annual Meeting and meetings of the Executive Board. He will work closely with the Executive Director and shall be an *ex officio* member of all committees. The Moderator shall be elected annually and may not serve more than two successive full terms. After a recommendation from the Trustees, he shall be elected during the Annual Meeting.

When the office of Executive Director is vacant and his time permits, the Moderator shall give leadership and counsel to the staff, Leadership Team and Association as needed. In case of the resignation or death of the Moderator before the end of his term, the Assistant Moderator automatically shall become the Moderator and the Executive Board shall elect another as Assistant Moderator.

2. After a recommendation from the Trustees, an **Assistant Moderator** shall be elected annually during the Annual Meeting. He shall perform all of the duties of the Moderator in his absence or at his request.

3. The **Clerk** shall make and keep a complete and accurate record of the proceedings of the Association in Annual Session, Special Sessions, and Executive Board meetings. The Clerk will make these available to all cooperating churches through the Associational office. Such records are Associational property and shall be filed in the Associational office.

In the absence of both the Moderator and the Assistant Moderator, the Clerk shall call the meeting to order and preside over the election of a Moderator *pro tem* who shall conduct the meeting. In the absence of the Clerk, the Assistant Clerk shall assume the above duties.

4. The **Treasurer** shall receive all monies belonging to the Association, deposit them in a bank designated by the Association, and maintain accurate records of all receipts, their source and purposes for which they were contributed. Monies shall be disbursed by the Treasurer according to the authorizations of the Association or the Executive Board. No special authorization will be necessary for payment of bills presented by Departments or Committees that do not exceed the amounts appropriated for their use.

The Treasurer shall apprise the Executive Board of the status of the treasury at each of their meetings and make a full report to the Association at the Annual Meeting.

In the absence of the Treasurer, the Assistant Treasurer shall assume the above duties.

The Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer shall be bonded or have other equivalent insurance with the Association assuming the expense.

5. Three **Trustees** from three different churches shall be elected to serve three-year terms on a rotating basis, one being elected each year. Trustee nominations shall be submitted at the Executive Board meeting prior to the Annual Meeting and voted on at Annual Meeting. A Trustee shall be allowed to serve two three-year terms. A Trustee shall be ineligible for reelection until one year since their last service has elapsed.

The Trustees shall have general oversight of all physical properties including the acquisition and disposal of office equipment. They are charged with responsibility for signing all legal documents.

They shall have no power to mortgage or transfer any property without specific authorization by the Association or the Executive Board.

SECTION D - ORGANIZATION

Leaders shall be elected by the Executive Board at the Annual Meeting after recommendations of the Trustees. They shall assume their terms of office immediately following their election. Their specific duties are outlined in the Role Descriptions in the Policies and Procedures Manual.

The Associational Moderator, Annual Meeting host pastor(s), Executive Director, and two at-large members appointed by the Moderator shall prepare a program for the Annual Meeting and recommend the speakers and alternates. The team shall also recommend the places, dates, and times for the Annual Meetings for the next two years.

Committees are essential to the smooth functioning of the Association. No two members of any committee may be from the same church.

1. The **Trustees** are responsible to select members for nomination at the next Annual Meeting to fill the offices of Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, Assistant Clerk, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Acts 1:8 Team Leaders, Committee Members other than the Trustees, and other nominations as may be referred to it by the Association or Executive Board. During the year the Trustees will make nominations to the Executive Board to fill any vacancies that may arise. The Trustees shall obtain consent of all nominees before placing their names in nomination.

The Trustees are responsible for studying the Constitution and Bylaws to determine needs for changes. Upon their initiative or instruction of the Executive Board, they will prepare suitable amendments and present them to the Association for consideration at the Annual Meeting. Trustees should also make themselves available for consultation regarding whether Association procedures are in accordance with the Constitution and Bylaws.

The Trustees are also responsible for reviewing membership status in the Association as outline in Section A-Membership of these Bylaws. Additionally, the Trustees are responsible for preparing and recommending appropriate resolutions to the Association for recognizing all services rendered by individuals, groups, and churches during the Annual Meeting. They may prepare position statement resolutions on regional issues bearing upon the spiritual well being of the Association and the Nation. Suggestions for any resolutions should be presented to the Trustees in draft form not later than the first session of the Annual Meeting.

2. The **Personnel Committee** shall consist of three members serving three-year terms with one being elected each year. A member may not succeed himself.

Personnel Committee responsibilities include recommending personnel policies and procedures to the Executive Board and developing and maintaining role descriptions for each paid staff position. This committee shall also cooperate with the Executive Director to receive applications for support staff positions, interview applicants, and make recommendations for employment to the Executive Board.

The committee should evaluate the work of the Executive Director annually and review his evaluation of other staff members. The Personnel Committee will make annual budget recommendations for staff salary and benefits to the Stewardship Committee. If the need should arise, the Personnel Committee, in consultation with the Executive Director, has responsibility for recommending termination of any staff member to the Executive Board.

3. The **Stewardship Committee** shall consist of five members, one of whom is the Treasurer who will serve as Chairman. Other than the Treasurer, members shall be elected for four-year terms with one being elected each year. A member may not succeed himself.

It shall be the responsibility of the Committee to prepare a proposed annual budget for review by the Executive Board before the Annual Meeting. The Committee shall present the final draft at the Annual Meeting for consideration of the Association.

SECTION E - LEADERSHIP TEAM

The **Leadership Team** shall be composed of Officers, the Acts 1:8 Team and others as deemed necessary by the Leadership Team Leader. The Executive Director shall serve as the Team Leader for the Leadership Team.

Four Acts 1:8 Team members (Local, Illinois, North America and International) shall be elected to serve three-year terms, or a major part thereof, shall be ineligible for reelection until at least one year has elapsed.

SECTION F- AMENDMENTS TO THE BYLAWS

Any proposed amendments to the By-Laws shall be submitted in writing to the Trustees. Recommended amendments shall be read at an early session of any Annual Meeting of the Association but shall not be voted upon until a later session. A two-thirds majority of the messengers voting is required to amend the By-Laws.

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS
191st Annual Meeting
October 17, 2021

The opening session of the 191st meeting of the Clear Creek Baptist Association was held at Caledonia Community Church.

1. Pastor Mike Sharp welcomed everyone and led in prayer.
2. Caledonia Praise Team led in worship.
3. Moderator Terry Kern called the meeting to order at 4:20 p.m.
4. Moderator Kern introduced the new Executive Director, Dr. Bob Burnett.
5. Clint Nale moved to accept the agenda as printed and the 2022 Annual Meeting location and date. Mike Miller seconded the motion. The motion carried.
6. Ashby Tillery, IBSA Zone Consultant, brought greetings from IBSA.
7. Denny Hydrick, Executive Director of Baptist Children's Home and Family Services, brought a report and greetings.
8. Church Planter Virgil Diel brought a report from Grace Community Baptist Church.
9. Moderator Kern led in prayer for local missions.
10. Treasurer Nancy Ralls represented the Stewardship Team and moved that the budget proposal for January-December 2022 be adopted. The motion carried.
11. Treasurer Nancy Ralls moved to accept the 2021 Treasurers Report as printed. Jim Haney seconded the motion. The motion carried.



Clint Nale, Interim Director

At this time last year, we were dealing with the effects of a pandemic as well as the beginning of a season without a Director of Missions. As I write this report for the overview of this recent year of associational ministry, we are still dealing with a pandemic, but we are at the end of a season without a Director of Missions.

EXECUTIVE BOARD

Terry Kern, Moderator

November 10, 2020

Moderator Mike Cole called the special called meeting of the Clear Creek Baptist Association to order at 7:00 pm. Thirty-one members representing seventeen churches were present.

Moderator Cole read the specifications to elect a search team and then accepted nominations from the floor for members of this team.

After many names were nominated, Jay Franklin moved to close nominations. Willie Rhymer seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mike Cole nominated three vote counters: Mike Sharp, Susie Lutz and Kerry Hill.

The counters reported that these individuals were voted to serve as members of the Executive Director Search Team: LaRue Parr, Terry Kern, Tom Gray, Darryl Williams, Paula Stairs, Richard Miller and Perry Williams. After the announcement, Richard Miller declined to serve. Dale Miller was the next alternative and she accepted.

January 12, 2021

The Clear Creek Baptist Association Executive Board meeting was held at Anna Heights Baptist Church for social distancing purposes due to the Covid-19 virus pandemic. Twenty members representing fifteen churches attended the meeting.

LaRue Parr, Executive Director Search Team Chairman, gave an update on their progress. The team is open to full-time or part-time and they are accepting resumes until April 5, 2021. He asked for continued prayer for the team.

The written record of the September 15, 2020 meeting was approved as printed. The written record of the November 2020 Special Called Executive Board meeting was approved as printed. The motion to accept the financial reports for the months of September – December carried.

May 11, 2021

Executive Director Search Team Chairman, LaRue Parr, gave an update on the team's progress.

The written record of the January 12, 2021 meeting was approved as printed. The motion to accept the financial reports for the months of January - April carried.

Bob Richardson, representing the Trustees, made a motion that states, "In regards to Grace Community Baptist Church, the Trustees move to dissolve the church plant in its present state as we consider other ministry options. The motion carried with no questions.

Representing the Trustees, Bob Richardson also moved that the Executive Board allow the Trustees to seek avenues to separate the association from the building that has been used by Grace Community Baptist Church. The question was asked about building insurance. Bob answered that the insurance is the association's responsibility until we are no longer owner of the building. The motion carried.

EXECUTIVE BOARD CONTINUED

Representing the Personnel Team, Claude Sadler moved that Virgil Diel be given two weeks salary as severance pay. All available funds from the Grace Community Baptist Church Fund will be used first, then the additional amount needed will be transferred from the General Fund to Grace Community Baptist Church Fund. The motion carried.

Clint gave a missions update. He explained that the Trustees want to keep the foundation of ministry that Grace Church has laid for future work in Cairo. And that the building and property itself needs to go, but the transition needed to be handled with respect to the former Cairo First Southern Baptist Church.

July 6, 2021

Moderator Mike Cole called the special called meeting of the Clear Creek Baptist Association to order at 7:00 pm. Twenty-seven members representing sixteen churches were present.

Interim Executive Director Clint Nale spoke about the nature of the meeting and explained the process that he and the Trustees went through to bring the motions presented.

Representing the Trustees, Chairman Bob Richardson moved to donate the building and property as is at 2728 Walnut Street Cairo, Illinois 62914 to the Southern Pride Senior Program Vienna, Illinois. Coming from a committee, no second was needed. After a few questions, the motion carried.

Representing the Trustees, Chairman Bob Richardson then moved to hire Attorney Elvis Cameron to do the legal work required for the donation, giving the Trustees approval and power to sign any and all documents for the successful transfer. Coming from a committee, no second was needed. The motion carried.

August 24, 2021

Moderator Terry Kern called the August 24, 2021, Special-Called Executive Board meeting of the Clear Creek Baptist Association to order at 7:00 p.m. Twenty-seven members and two guests representing eighteen churches attended the meeting.

Executive Director Search Team chairman, LaRue Parr, introduced Executive Director candidate Bob Burnett. Bob gave his testimony and answered questions from the board.

LaRue Parr, representing the Executive Director Search Team, moved that Dr. Robert Burnett be called to serve as Executive Director for Clear Creek Baptist Association. Voting was done by ballot.

Terry appointed Nancy Ralls, Mike Miller, and Richard Miller as counters. The counters tabulated the votes. Terry read the results. The results were as follows: 25 yes and 1 no. Bob accepted the invitation to become the Executive Director for Clear Creek Baptist Association.

And again, Allen Plott, representing the Trustees, moved that a new computer be purchased as the new Executive Director chooses with the expense not exceeding \$1000. The motion carried.

ILLINOIS BAPTIST STATE ASSOCIATION PARTNERSHIP REPORT

IBSA's annual partnership report usually summarizes ministry results from almost one-thousand churches, church plants, and mission congregations here in Illinois. There's always lots to celebrate. And then there was 2020. Like most areas of life, the Covid-19 pandemic hit churches hard. Comparing Annual Church Profile reports in 2019 to the new numbers in 2020:

- Baptisms recorded by IBSA churches were down 42% from 3,553 to 2,047.
- Missions projects participation dropped 22%, from 19,824 to 15,475.
- While Sunday school attendance held steady during the times churches were able to meet, worship attendance declined 9%.
- Missions giving through the Cooperative Program dropped 12.3%, from \$6,205,953 to \$5,443,104.
- Giving to the Mission Illinois Offering declined 15.2%, from \$386,057 to \$327,416. 2021 has shown some encouraging recovery, but the return to pre-Covid levels is still on going.

Cooperative Program giving has averaged 2-4% below 2019 levels, down by about \$84,000 overall by August. The Mission Illinois Offering is underway. Our annual survey of church needs in November 2020 showed pastors and church leaders placed "spiritual support and inspiration" at the top of their list, followed closely by "ideas and examples for ministry during the pandemic." At least 6-in-10 leaders turned to IBSA for valuable information and personal support, as the state association turned to pandemic-related ministry assistance and content delivered online.

Entering 2021, pastors identified leader development as their churches' number one need, followed by help with technology, and revitalization. In fact, 8-in-10 leaders say church revitalization is needed now—either urgently, or in the next couple of years. IBSA draws on its staff and the network of churches to meet these needs, and to mobilize for missions. During weeks of quarantine and limited resources, Illinois Baptist Disaster Relief quickly developed a food distribution ministry, delivering much needed supplies all over the state. IBSA churches opened food banks, and shared Christ's love with hurting people. A network of ministry partners, including D-R volunteers and national missions partners made it work. By the fall of 2021, pastors in churches that started food ministries were reporting salvations and baptisms resulting from those personal contacts with people in need. The best sign of recovery so far? The return of summer camps. In cooperation with local associations and churches, IBSA once again offered a full summer of discipleship and activity at Streator and Lake Sallateeska Baptist Camps. In all, 112 young people were saved.

From the Executive Director:

In 2010 a Lincoln cent penny was sold at a private auction for \$1.7 million dollars. One of the rarest pennies, its value was due to a mechanical error with the machines that stamped the pennies. The machines made a very small number of bronze pennies because copper, which was supposed to be replaced because of war rations, was snuck and unnoticed in the stamping machine. This incident in 1943 led to "the most famous error coin in American numismatics." How a one cent coin can have a value of \$1.7 million dollars is mind-boggling to me! What unimaginable value was placed on a small coin, basically worthless had this error not occurred.

This Annual Report is our way to communicate our stewardship of resources to you, our supporters, friends, and co-laborers in ministry.
