# **CONSTITUTION**

## **ARTICLE I - NAME**

The name of this body shall be Clear Creek Baptist Association.

## **ARTICLE II - AFFILIATION**

The Association shall affiliate with the Illinois Baptist State Association, the Southern Baptist Convention and the Canadian National Baptist Convention.

## **ARTICLE III - ARTICLES OF FAITH**

The Association shall subscribe to the *Baptist Faith and Message* adopted by the Southern Baptist Convention on June 14, 2000.

## **ARTICLE IV - MISSION**

The Mission of Clear Creek Baptist Association is encouraging churches toward effectively fulfilling the Great Commission, equipping Christian leaders, and inspiring cooperation among God's people.

## **ARTICLE V - MEMBERSHIP**

Section 1. The Association is composed of Baptist Churches who wish to cooperate in carrying out the Mission of the Association and are in harmony with the purpose and spirit of the *Baptist Faith and Message*. Member churches shall annually submit Church Profile reports to the Association. Member churches shall contribute financial support to the Association each year. Member churches are encouraged to be represented by Messengers to the Annual Meeting and membership in the Executive Board.

Section 2. Membership in the Association shall be purely voluntary. The Association shall not exercise any authority over the churches in respect to their doctrines or method of work; but may exercise the right to counsel and advise any church that appears to have departed from the faith and practice of the New Testament, and to withdraw fellowship from any church and refuse to recognize messengers from such church that might vary fundamentally from the teachings of the *Baptist Faith and Message*.

## **ARTICLE VI - ANNUAL MEETING**

Section 1. The Association shall meet annually in October on the date and place established by action of the Association at the previous year's meeting.

Section 2. Messengers to the Annual Meeting shall be the senior Pastors of member churches, their elected Board members, and three Messengers elected by each church. Other Messengers shall include elected Associational Officers, Committee Chairmen, and the Acts 1:8 Team. Each Messenger shall have one vote.

## **ARTICLE VII - THE BOARD**

The Association shall have a Board made up of leaders of the Association charged with responsibility of carrying on the business of the Association during the interim between Annual Meetings.

## **ARTICLE VIII - PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE**

Parliamentary proceedings of the Association shall be guided by *Robert's Rules of Order*, latest revision.

## **ARTICLE IX - OFFICERS**

The Officers of the Association shall be Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, Assistant Clerk, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, and Trustees. The Executive Director shall be an *ex officio* Officer of the Association serving as the primary executive and administrative officer. This function shall be performed in consultation with the Moderator and the Board. All shall be members of churches affiliated with the Association.

## **ARTICLE X - ORGANIZATION**

Section 1. To fulfill its mission and assist member churches effectively, the Association shall provide organizational leaders. Leaders will provide motivation and training by promoting and publicizing all associational, state, and denominational meetings, activities, and projects. Leaders may enlist others to assist them in accomplishing their work. Leaders may include an Acts 1:8 Team—Local, Illinois, North America, International and other offices as may be deemed needed by the Association or the Board.

Section 2. Active committees are essential to the effective functioning of the Association. The Association currently has three standing committees: Personnel, Stewardship and Trustees. Other committees may be added or those no longer serving a purpose may be deleted by action of the Association or the Board.

## **ARTICLE XI - AMENDMENTS**

All proposed amendments to the Constitution shall be submitted in writing to the Trustees. Recommended amendments shall be presented at two consecutive annual meetings, the first for reading only, and the second for discussion and vote. A two-thirds majority of the messengers voting is required to amend the Constitution.

## **BY-LAWS OF THE CONSTITUTION**

These By-laws of the Constitution are designed to assist the leaders in carrying out their responsibilities in directing the internal affairs of the Association. They apply to the various Articles of the Constitution needing such procedural guidelines. The Sections are in the same sequence and the headings coincide with the Articles of the same name.

### **SECTION A - MEMBERSHIP**

1. A church seeking membership in the Association shall forward a petitionary letter to the Trustees at least sixty days before the Annual Meeting of the Association. Attached to the letter should be the Church's Annual Church Profile form completed for a twelve-month period, a copy of the Articles of Faith, and a copy of the Church's Constitution & By-laws adopted by the Church.

2. The Trustees shall review the request and make any further investigation they deem necessary or desirable. Based on their findings, the Trustees shall make a recommendation to the Association during a business session of the Annual Meeting. A three-fourths majority of the messengers voting shall be required for admission.

3. If a church fails to file an Annual Church Profile form for three consecutive years, it shall be considered as having withdrawn from the Association. If a church fails to submit financial support for three consecutive years, it shall be considered as having withdrawn from the Association. Upon a vote of the Executive Board at Annual Meeting, the church will be dropped from membership.

4. In the event any member church in practice appears to violate the Articles of Faith adopted by the Association, the Trustees will investigate. If a violation is found, an attempt will be made to bring about reconciliation. Failing in this, the Trustees will make appropriate recommendations to the Association during its Annual Meeting. Withdrawal of fellowship will require a two-thirds majority of the messengers voting.

### **SECTION B - THE BOARD**

1. The Board shall be called the Executive Board and shall be composed of the senior Pastors of member churches, one elected Executive Board Member from each church, the Associational Moderator and all Associational Officers, Acts 1:8 Team Leaders, and standing Committee Chairmen along with the Executive Director and regular staff members.

2. The Executive Board is responsible for the work of the Association during the interim between Annual Meetings. They shall meet every other month starting with January. The regular dates shall be established by the Associational Calendar after approval at the Annual Meeting. The Moderator may call a special meeting by notifying all members of the Executive Board at least a week before the meeting date. Fifteen members will be required for a quorum to conduct business. The Board shall present a full report to the Association during the Annual Meeting.

3. The Executive Board shall also be responsible for employing the Executive Director and other staff members, establishing terms of employment, and termination of their services. In the event the Executive Director position is vacant, the Board shall elect a special Search Committee of seven members selected from the Executive Board. This committee shall be comprised of individuals from seven different churches, and include at least one female member, as well as one layperson. Working with the Executive Board, they shall establish desired criteria. They shall then seek candidates, interview, and make recommendations to the Executive Board.

4. Executive Board Members elected to represent affiliated churches should keep their respective churches informed of actions and goals of the Board. In the event a member church loses representation through resignation or death, a new Board Member should be elected to fill the vacancy.

## SECTION C - OFFICERS

Except for filling vacancies, all officers shall be elected during the Annual Meeting after nominations are made by the Trustees. A majority vote of messengers voting is required for election. Each officer of the Association shall deliver all items that pertain to his office to his successor upon completion of his duties. \*

\* Where masculine gender is used, it is considered as generic and may apply to male or female members.

The following duties, terms of office, and method of election apply to the officers indicated:

1. The **Moderator** shall preside over the Annual Meeting and meetings of the Executive Board. He will work closely with the Executive Director and shall be an *ex officio* member of all committees. The Moderator shall be elected annually and may not serve more than two successive full terms. After a recommendation from the Trustees, he shall be elected during the Annual Meeting.

When the office of Executive Director is vacant and his time permits, the Moderator shall give leadership and counsel to the staff, Leadership Team and Association as needed. In case of the resignation or death of the Moderator before the end of his term, the Assistant Moderator automatically shall become the Moderator and the Executive Board shall elect another as Assistant Moderator.

2. After a recommendation from the Trustees, an **Assistant Moderator** shall be elected annually during the Annual Meeting. He shall perform all of the duties of the Moderator in his absence or at his request.

3. The **Clerk** shall make and keep a complete and accurate record of the proceedings of the Association in Annual Session, Special Sessions, and Executive Board meetings. The Clerk will make these available to all cooperating churches through the Associational office. Such records are Associational property and shall be filed in the Associational office.

In the absence of both the Moderator and the Assistant Moderator, the Clerk shall call the meeting to order and preside over the election of a Moderator *pro tem* who shall conduct the meeting. In the absence of the Clerk, the Assistant Clerk shall assume the above duties.

4. The **Treasurer** shall receive all monies belonging to the Association, deposit them in a bank designated by the Association, and maintain accurate records of all receipts, their source and purposes for which they were contributed. Monies shall be disbursed by the Treasurer according to the authorizations of the Association or the Executive Board. No special authorization will be necessary for payment of bills presented by Departments or Committees that do not exceed the amounts appropriated for their use.

The Treasurer shall apprise the Executive Board of the status of the treasury at each of their meetings and make a full report to the Association at the Annual Meeting.

In the absence of the Treasurer, the Assistant Treasurer shall assume the above duties.

The Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer shall be bonded or have other equivalent insurance with the Association assuming the expense.

5. Three **Trustees** from three different churches shall be elected to serve three-year terms on a rotating basis, one being elected each year. Trustee nominations shall be submitted at the Executive Board meeting prior to the Annual Meeting and voted on at Annual Meeting. A Trustee shall be allowed to serve two three-year terms. A Trustee shall be ineligible for reelection until one year since their last service has elapsed.

The Trustees shall have general oversight of all physical properties including the acquisition and disposal of office equipment. They are charged with responsibility for signing all legal documents.

They shall have no power to mortgage or transfer any property without specific authorization by the Association or the Executive Board.

## **SECTION D - ORGANIZATION**

Leaders shall be elected by the Executive Board at the Annual Meeting after recommendations of the Trustees. They shall assume their terms of office immediately following their election. Their specific duties are outlined in the Role Descriptions in the Policies and Procedures Manual.

The Associational Moderator, Annual Meeting host pastor(s), Executive Director, and two at-large members appointed by the Moderator shall prepare a program for the Annual Meeting and recommend the speakers and alternates. The team shall also recommend the places, dates, and times for the Annual Meetings for the next two years.

Committees are essential to the smooth functioning of the Association. No two members of any committee may be from the same church.

1. The **Trustees** are responsible to select members for nomination at the next Annual Meeting to fill the offices of Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, Assistant Clerk, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Acts 1:8 Team Leaders, Committee Members other than the Trustees, and other nominations as may be referred to it by the Association or Executive Board. During the year the Trustees will make nominations to the Executive Board to fill any vacancies that may arise. The Trustees shall obtain consent of all nominees before placing their names in nomination.

The Trustees are responsible for studying the Constitution and Bylaws to determine needs for changes. Upon their initiative or instruction of the Executive Board, they will prepare suitable amendments and present them to the Association for consideration at the Annual Meeting. Trustees should also make themselves available for consultation regarding whether Association procedures are in accordance with the Constitution and Bylaws.

The Trustees are also responsible for reviewing membership status in the Association as outline in Section A-Membership of these Bylaws. Additionally, the Trustees are responsible for preparing and recommending appropriate resolutions to the Association for recognizing all services rendered by individuals, groups, and churches during the Annual Meeting. They may prepare position statement resolutions on regional issues bearing upon the spiritual well being of the Association and the Nation. Suggestions for any resolutions should be presented to the Trustees in draft form not later than the first session of the Annual Meeting.



2. The **Personnel Committee** shall consist of three members serving three-year terms with one being elected each year. A member may not succeed himself.

Personnel Committee responsibilities include recommending personnel policies and procedures to the Executive Board and developing and maintaining role descriptions for each paid staff position. This committee shall also cooperate with the Executive Director to receive applications for support staff positions, interview applicants, and make recommendations for employment to the Executive Board.

The committee should evaluate the work of the Executive Director annually and review his evaluation of other staff members. The Personnel Committee will make annual budget recommendations for staff salary and benefits to the Stewardship Committee. If the need should arise, the Personnel Committee, in consultation with the Executive Director, has responsibility for recommending termination of any staff member to the Executive Board.

3. The **Stewardship Committee** shall consist of five members, one of whom is the Treasurer who will serve as Chairman. Other than the Treasurer, members shall be elected for four-year terms with one being elected each year. A member may not succeed himself.

It shall be the responsibility of the Committee to prepare a proposed annual budget for review by the Executive Board before the Annual Meeting. The Committee shall present the final draft at the Annual Meeting for consideration of the Association.

## **SECTION E - LEADERSHIP TEAM**

The **Leadership Team** shall be composed of Officers, the Acts 1:8 Team and others as deemed necessary by the Leadership Team Leader. The Executive Director shall serve as the Team Leader for the Leadership Team.

Four Acts 1:8 Team members (Local, Illinois, North America and International) shall be elected to serve three-year terms, or a major part thereof, shall be ineligible for reelection until at least one year has elapsed.

## **SECTION F- AMENDMENTS TO THE BYLAWS**

Any proposed amendments to the By-Laws shall be submitted in writing to the Trustees. Recommended amendments shall be read at an early session of any Annual Meeting of the Association but shall not be voted upon until a later session. A two-thirds majority of the messengers voting is required to amend the By-Laws.



Our procedural review is substantially less in scope than a financial statement review. Accordingly, we have not obtained such limited assurance.

Enclosed in this document are the procedures we recommend for your Association. We suggest that you review these recommendations and adjust your policies accordingly.

**TRUSTEES REPORT**  
**Bob Richardson, Allen Plott, Willie Rhymer**

The Association has delegated to the Trustees the ongoing oversight of its property at 2825 East Vienna Street in Anna, the Kingdom Builders Fund, the Building and Maintenance Fund and the Office Equipment Fund. Following is a report of activities undertaken in fulfillment of this responsibility.

**Property**

Trustees report that the building and grounds are in good condition.

**Kingdom Builders Fund**

## **IBSA Partnership Report • Fall 2023**

**A**s your IBSA network continues to invest in the health, growth, and mission of its nearly 900 member congregations, a new day of church health is emerging, and lives are being changed across our home-state mission field. The Annual Church Profile report, published earlier this year, reflects this:

- Baptisms recorded by IBSA churches were up 40% from 2021 (2,787 vs. 1,985).
- Over 18% more churches recorded baptisms (434 vs 367).
- VBS enrollment increased almost 38% over 2021 (21,673 vs. 15,735).
- Worship attendance statewide rose nearly 13% from the previous year (52,666 vs. 46,747).
- Still, inflationary and other concerns contributed to Cooperative Program and Mission Illinois offering giving from churches declining slightly from the previous year (CP \$5,513,999 vs \$5,835,888 and MIO \$308,951 vs \$335,734).

Several strategic shifts first implemented in 2019 are helping the network deliver value to churches with increasingly different needs, providing processes and resources that enable each church to thrive.

**Working to help churches revitalize.** IBSA's Health Team is directly engaged with 84 churches and 15 local associations in revitalization processes. The most recent Church Needs survey indicates the tide is turning toward healthier churches. The number of churches responding that revitalization is needed "now" or "urgently" has decreased 28% since 2018.

**Guiding churches to take their next steps.** IBSA's Health, Growth, and Mission teams are engaged with at least 130 churches in various "Next Step" processes. These strategic consultations help guide church leaders toward a contextualized plan for ministry, based on the top needs the church identifies. For example, this year Next Step consultations have already equipped more than 60 churches with new evangelism strategies and assisted almost 30 churches in their search for a new pastor or ministry staff member.

**Helping churches reach and disciple the next generation.** Through mid-year, nearly 1,000 children and students have already been disciplined through Super Summer, Go Chicago student mission week, and IBSA camps at the Lake Sallateeska and Streator facilities. Over 800 more students are expected at Youth Encounter and AWSOM events this fall. And 7 different campus ministries continue at Illinois colleges and universities.

**Multiplying churches.** IBSA has helped launch 6 new churches this year, with several more in process. In addition, more than 30 churches planted over the last few years are still being helped with support.

**Mobilizing volunteers to meet community needs.** Illinois Baptist Disaster Relief has deployed 237 trained volunteers to provide labor, meals, and support to people experiencing loss, working at over 340 different job sites. In partnership with the North American Mission Board, IBSA helped host an August 4-5 Serve Tour in Chicago that saw more than 700 missions volunteers complete 46 projects and engage in 980 gospel conversations, with at least 26 coming to faith in Christ that weekend.

With over 8 million people who do not have a personal relationship with Jesus, there is no shortage of spiritual work in this increasingly diverse Illinois mission field. As a statewide network of churches, IBSA is working hard to support the churches and church plants that are our state's primary missionaries.

Thank you for your church's participation and cooperative giving that fuel the mission of taking the gospel to more than 8 million lost people in Illinois.

We are thankful for the Lord's provision in bringing new staff to BCHFS and supplying the material needs to serve our clients and residents. We are also thankful to you our generous churches and donors for your partnership in this ministry.

### Life Stewardship

BFI's work in the Life Stewardship area probably, more than any other division, represents the heart of BFI. We provide our most custom, time sensitive work in the area of Christian Estate Planning. This service—often the largest single act of stewardship—is provided without charge. BFI has helped close to 200 families put a Christian Estate Plan in place. Collectively, they will give over \$250 million to permanently support Kingdom causes. BFI also continues to see churches and individuals throughout the state utilize the **Biblical Financial Management** video study to grow in the area of Christian stewardship. This eight-part video series (with downloadable study guides) is available for free under the "Resources" tab of our website.

### Church/Ministry Loans

The year 2023 marks the 10th Anniversary of BFI investing in church expansion through our bond program. Sold in \$1,000 increments, these bonds provide a low cost loan for the church while returning a stable, low risk return to the investor. In ten years, BFI has written 92 bond issues for churches and ministries in every section of our state. In this same time period, BFI has raised more than \$21 million for the loans. To date, BFI has operated our loan and bond program without default.

### Custodial Investing

BFI offers several ways for Christ followers to save that are designed to honor the Lord both with their object (where the funds are invested) and method (how the funds are invested). In 2023, both our Cash (2.00%) and Bonds account (4.75% for a 5 year maturity) rates hit high water marks. Over the last ten years, the Long Term Fixed Income has produced a steady yield of 4.71% and an average return of 5.60% per year through 2022. The balanced fund is our newest, begun in 2019. It has seen an average total return of 12.5% since the fund began. BFI currently manages 1,715 custodial accounts valued at more than \$64 million. In the last ten years, these accounts have generated more than \$10 million in interest which returned to Illinois Baptist churches and individuals.

### Educational Scholarships

Providing educational scholarships is the oldest area of our work. BFI manages 34 scholarship endowments and each year distributes somewhere between \$80,000 - \$100,000 depending on earnings and the number and type of applicants. In the last ten years, BFI has invested approximately \$800,000 in the education of Illinois Baptists students.

### Church Legacy

The Legacy Program allows closing churches to revert their remaining assets to BFI and then establishes a "missions fund" in the churches name. This fund provides ongoing support for organizations the church selects—in perpetuity—while allowing the church to have ongoing impact long after the doors are closed. In addition to the "funds" creation, BFI works with church planting partners to attempt to replant a new church start at that location. To date, 38 churches have had their resources maintained through the Legacy Program for an approximate value of \$2.24 million. Of this number, 23 have resulted in a church that is either space sharing, re-planted, or now meeting at that location.
