# **CONSTITUTION**

## **ARTICLE I - NAME**

The name of this body shall be Clear Creek Baptist Association.

## **ARTICLE II - AFFILIATION**

The Association shall affiliate with the Illinois Baptist State Association, the Southern Baptist Convention and the Canadian National Baptist Convention.

## **ARTICLE III - ARTICLES OF FAITH**

The Association shall subscribe to the *Baptist Faith and Message* adopted by the Southern Baptist Convention on June 14, 2000.

## **ARTICLE IV - MISSION**

The Mission of Clear Creek Baptist Association is encouraging churches toward effectively fulfilling the Great Commission, equipping Christian leaders, and inspiring cooperation among God's people.

## **ARTICLE V - MEMBERSHIP**

Section 1. The Association is composed of Baptist Churches who wish to cooperate in carrying out the Mission of the Association and are in harmony with the purpose and spirit of the *Baptist Faith and Message*. Member churches shall annually submit Church Profile reports to the Association. Member churches shall contribute financial support to the Association each year. Member churches are encouraged to be represented by Messengers to the Annual Meeting and membership in the Executive Board.

Section 2. Membership in the Association shall be purely voluntary. The Association shall not exercise any authority over the churches in respect to their doctrines or method of work; but may exercise the right to counsel and advise any church that appears to have departed from the faith and practice of the New Testament, and to withdraw fellowship from any church and refuse to recognize messengers from such church that might vary fundamentally from the teachings of the *Baptist Faith and Message*.

## **ARTICLE VI - ANNUAL MEETING**

Section 1. The Association shall meet annually in October on the date and place established by action of the Association at the previous year's meeting.

Section 2. Messengers to the Annual Meeting shall be the senior Pastors of member churches, their elected Board members, and three Messengers elected by each church. Other Messengers shall include elected Associational Officers, Committee Chairmen, and the Acts 1:8 Team. Each Messenger shall have one vote.

## **ARTICLE VII - THE BOARD**

The Association shall have a Board made up of leaders of the Association charged with responsibility of carrying on the business of the Association during the interim between Annual Meetings.

## **ARTICLE VIII - PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE**

Parliamentary proceedings of the Association shall be guided by *Robert's Rules of Order*, latest revision.

## **ARTICLE IX - OFFICERS**

The Officers of the Association shall be Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, Assistant Clerk, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, and Trustees. The Executive Director shall be an *ex officio* Officer of the Association serving as the primary executive and administrative officer. This function shall be performed in consultation with the Moderator and the Board. All shall be members of churches affiliated with the Association.

## **ARTICLE X - ORGANIZATION**

Section 1. To fulfill its mission and assist member churches effectively, the Association shall provide organizational leaders. Leaders will provide motivation and training by promoting and publicizing all associational, state, and denominational meetings, activities, and projects. Leaders may enlist others to assist them in accomplishing their work. Leaders may include an Acts 1:8 Team—Local, Illinois, North America, International and other offices as may be deemed needed by the Association or the Board.

Section 2. Active committees are essential to the effective functioning of the Association. The Association currently has three standing committees: Personnel, Stewardship and Trustees. Other committees may be added or those no longer serving a purpose may be deleted by action of the Association or the Board.

## **ARTICLE XI - AMENDMENTS**

All proposed amendments to the Constitution shall be submitted in writing to the Trustees. Recommended amendments shall be presented at two consecutive annual meetings, the first for reading only, and the second for discussion and vote. A two-thirds majority of the messengers voting is required to amend the Constitution.

## **BY-LAWS OF THE CONSTITUTION**

These By-laws of the Constitution are designed to assist the leaders in carrying out their responsibilities in directing the internal affairs of the Association. They apply to the various Articles of the Constitution needing such procedural guidelines. The Sections are in the same sequence and the headings coincide with the Articles of the same name.

### **SECTION A - MEMBERSHIP**

1. A church seeking membership in the Association shall forward a petitionary letter to the Trustees at least sixty days before the Annual Meeting of the Association. Attached to the letter should be the Church's Annual Church Profile form completed for a twelve-month period, a copy of the Articles of Faith, and a copy of the Church's Constitution & By-laws adopted by the Church.

2. The Trustees shall review the request and make any further investigation they deem necessary or desirable. Based on their findings, the Trustees shall make a recommendation to the Association during a business session of the Annual Meeting. A three-fourths majority of the messengers voting shall be required for admission.

3. If a church fails to file an Annual Church Profile form for three consecutive years, it shall be considered as having withdrawn from the Association. If a church fails to submit financial support for three consecutive years, it shall be considered as having withdrawn from the Association. Upon a vote of the Executive Board at Annual Meeting, the church will be dropped from membership.

4. In the event any member church in practice appears to violate the Articles of Faith adopted by the Association, the Trustees will investigate. If a violation is found, an attempt will be made to bring about reconciliation. Failing in this, the Trustees will make appropriate recommendations to the Association during its Annual Meeting. Withdrawal of fellowship will require a two-thirds majority of the messengers voting.

### **SECTION B - THE BOARD**

1. The Board shall be called the Executive Board and shall be composed of the senior Pastors of member churches, one elected Executive Board Member from each church, the Associational Moderator and all Associational Officers, Acts 1:8 Team Leaders, and standing Committee Chairmen along with the Executive Director and regular staff members.

2. The Executive Board is responsible for the work of the Association during the interim between Annual Meetings. They shall meet every other month starting with January. The regular dates shall be established by the Associational Calendar after approval at the Annual Meeting. The Moderator may call a special meeting by notifying all members of the Executive Board at least a week before the meeting date. Fifteen members will be required for a quorum to conduct business. The Board shall present a full report to the Association during the Annual Meeting.

3. The Executive Board shall also be responsible for employing the Executive Director and other staff members, establishing terms of employment, and termination of their services. In the event the Executive Director position is vacant, the Board shall elect a special Search Committee of seven members selected from the Executive Board. This committee shall be comprised of individuals from seven different churches, and include at least one female member, as well as one layperson. Working with the Executive Board, they shall establish desired criteria. They shall then seek candidates, interview, and make recommendations to the Executive Board.

4. Executive Board Members elected to represent affiliated churches should keep their respective churches informed of actions and goals of the Board. In the event a member church loses representation through resignation or death, a new Board Member should be elected to fill the vacancy.

### SECTION C - OFFICERS

Except for filling vacancies, all officers shall be elected during the Annual Meeting after nominations are made by the Trustees. A majority vote of messengers voting is required for election. Each officer of the Association shall deliver all items that pertain to his office to his successor upon completion of his duties. \*

\* Where masculine gender is used, it is considered as generic and may apply to male or female members.

The following duties, terms of office, and method of election apply to the officers indicated:

1. The **Moderator** shall preside over the Annual Meeting and meetings of the Executive Board. He will work closely with the Executive Director and shall be an *ex officio* member of all committees. The Moderator shall be elected annually and may not serve more than two successive full terms. After a recommendation from the Trustees, he shall be elected during the Annual Meeting.

When the office of Executive Director is vacant and his time permits, the Moderator shall give leadership and counsel to the staff, Leadership Team and Association as needed. In case of the resignation or death of the Moderator before the end of his term, the Assistant Moderator automatically shall become the Moderator and the Executive Board shall elect another as Assistant Moderator.

2. After a recommendation from the Trustees, an **Assistant Moderator** shall be elected annually during the Annual Meeting. He shall perform all of the duties of the Moderator in his absence or at his request.

3. The **Clerk** shall make and keep a complete and accurate record of the proceedings of the Association in Annual Session, Special Sessions, and Executive Board meetings. The Clerk will make these available to all cooperating churches through the Associational office. Such records are Associational property and shall be filed in the Associational office.

In the absence of both the Moderator and the Assistant Moderator, the Clerk shall call the meeting to order and preside over the election of a Moderator *pro tem* who shall conduct the meeting. In the absence of the Clerk, the Assistant Clerk shall assume the above duties.

4. The **Treasurer** shall receive all monies belonging to the Association, deposit them in a bank designated by the Association, and maintain accurate records of all receipts, their source and purposes for which they were contributed. Monies shall be disbursed by the Treasurer according to the authorizations of the Association or the Executive Board. No special authorization will be necessary for payment of bills presented by Departments or Committees that do not exceed the amounts appropriated for their use.

The Treasurer shall apprise the Executive Board of the status of the treasury at each of their meetings and make a full report to the Association at the Annual Meeting.

In the absence of the Treasurer, the Assistant Treasurer shall assume the above duties.

The Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer shall be bonded or have other equivalent insurance with the Association assuming the expense.

5. Three **Trustees** from three different churches shall be elected to serve three-year terms on a rotating basis, one being elected each year. Trustee nominations shall be submitted at the Executive Board meeting prior to the Annual Meeting and voted on at Annual Meeting. A Trustee shall be allowed to serve two three-year terms. A Trustee shall be ineligible for reelection until one year since their last service has elapsed.

The Trustees shall have general oversight of all physical properties including the acquisition and disposal of office equipment. They are charged with responsibility for signing all legal documents.

They shall have no power to mortgage or transfer any property without specific authorization by the Association or the Executive Board.

## SECTION D - ORGANIZATION

Leaders shall be elected by the Executive Board at the Annual Meeting after recommendations of the Trustees. They shall assume their terms of office immediately following their election. Their specific duties are outlined in the Role Descriptions in the Policies and Procedures Manual.

The Associational Moderator, Annual Meeting host pastor(s), Executive Director, and two at-large members appointed by the Moderator shall prepare a program for the Annual Meeting and recommend the speakers and alternates. The team shall also recommend the places, dates, and times for the Annual Meetings for the next two years.

Committees are essential to the smooth functioning of the Association. No two members of any committee may be from the same church.

1. The **Trustees** are responsible to select members for nomination at the next Annual Meeting to fill the offices of Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, Assistant Clerk, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Acts 1:8 Team Leaders, Committee Members other than the Trustees, and other nominations as may be referred to it by the Association or Executive Board. During the year the Trustees will make nominations to the Executive Board to fill any vacancies that may arise. The Trustees shall obtain consent of all nominees before placing their names in nomination.

The Trustees are responsible for studying the Constitution and Bylaws to determine needs for changes. Upon their initiative or instruction of the Executive Board, they will prepare suitable amendments and present them to the Association for consideration at the Annual Meeting. Trustees should also make themselves available for consultation regarding whether Association procedures are in accordance with the Constitution and Bylaws.

The Trustees are also responsible for reviewing membership status in the Association as outline in Section A-Membership of these Bylaws. Additionally, the Trustees are responsible for preparing and recommending appropriate resolutions to the Association for recognizing all services rendered by individuals, groups, and churches during the Annual Meeting. They may prepare position statement resolutions on regional issues bearing upon the spiritual well being of the Association and the Nation. Suggestions for any resolutions should be presented to the Trustees in draft form not later than the first session of the Annual Meeting.

2. The **Personnel Committee** shall consist of three members serving three-year terms with one being elected each year. A member may not succeed himself.

Personnel Committee responsibilities include recommending personnel policies and procedures to the Executive Board and developing and maintaining role descriptions for each paid staff position. This committee shall also cooperate with the Executive Director to receive applications for support staff positions, interview applicants, and make recommendations for employment to the Executive Board.

The committee should evaluate the work of the Executive Director annually and review his evaluation of other staff members. The Personnel Committee will make annual budget recommendations for staff salary and benefits to the Stewardship Committee. If the need should arise, the Personnel Committee, in consultation with the Executive Director, has responsibility for recommending termination of any staff member to the Executive Board.

3. The **Stewardship Committee** shall consist of five members, one of whom is the Treasurer who will serve as Chairman. Other than the Treasurer, members shall be elected for four-year terms with one being elected each year. A member may not succeed himself.

It shall be the responsibility of the Committee to prepare a proposed annual budget for review by the Executive Board before the Annual Meeting. The Committee shall present the final draft at the Annual Meeting for consideration of the Association.

## **SECTION E - LEADERSHIP TEAM**

The **Leadership Team** shall be composed of Officers, the Acts 1:8 Team and others as deemed necessary by the Leadership Team Leader. The Executive Director shall serve as the Team Leader for the Leadership Team.

Four Acts 1:8 Team members (Local, Illinois, North America and International) shall be elected to serve three-year terms, or a major part thereof, shall be ineligible for reelection until at least one year has elapsed.

## **SECTION F- AMENDMENTS TO THE BYLAWS**

Any proposed amendments to the By-Laws shall be submitted in writing to the Trustees. Recommended amendments shall be read at an early session of any Annual Meeting of the Association but shall not be voted upon until a later session. A two-thirds majority of the messengers voting is required to amend the By-Laws.



Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion. A financial statement review obtains limited assurance that there are no material modifications needed to be in conformity with the applicable financial reporting framework. Our procedural review is substantially less in scope than a financial statement review. Accordingly, we have not obtained such limited assurance.

Enclosed in this document are the procedures we recommend for your Association. We suggest that you review these recommendations and adjust your policies accordingly.

## **EXECUTIVE BOARD**

### **Darryl Williams, Moderator**

#### **November 12, 2024**

Moderator Darryl Williams called the Executive Board of the Clear Creek Baptist Association to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the association building with eighteen members representing fourteen churches attended the meeting.

The written record of the September 2024 meeting was approved as printed. The motion to accept the financial reports for the months of September – October 2024 carried.

Representing the Trustees, Chairman Allen Plott moved “to allow Executive Assistant Shelly Pender to apply for an office credit card in her name and when the time arrives that we have an acting Executive Director, add his name as well.” The motion carried.

#### **January 14, 2025**

Moderator Darryl Williams called the Executive Board of the Clear Creek Baptist Association to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the association building with twenty-three members representing seventeen churches and two guests attended the meeting.

The written record of the November 2024 meeting was approved as printed. The motion to accept the financial reports for the months of November – December 2024 carried.

The 2024 Calendar Budget Report was presented and accepted.

In miscellaneous business, Moderator Williams read a letter, received the day of the board meeting, from Fellowship Baptist Church that stated the church had voted December 4<sup>th</sup> to formally disassociate from Clear Creek Baptist Association. Motion to receive the church’s decision was reluctantly made by Mike Sharp and seconded by Terry Kern. The motion carried.

#### **March 11, 2025**

Moderator Darryl Williams called the Executive Board of the Clear Creek Baptist Association to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the association building with twenty-eight members representing nineteen churches and one guest attended the meeting.

Terry Kern, Chairman of the Executive Director Search Team brought a recommendation of a vote from the search team that states,

“Representing the Executive Director Search Team, I move that a vote be taken to guide the search team, with God’s will, in the direction the CCBA Executive Board desires us to pursue. The vote has two options 1. To direct the search team to pursue a multi-leader model for the association or 2. To direct the search team to pursue a part-time Executive Director.”

Coming from a committee, no second was needed. Much discussion and questions were raised. Clint Nale then moved to amend the motion to add as a write-in option to continue seeking a full-time Executive Director position. Perry Williams seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Clint Nale then moved to close questions. Don Williams seconded the motion, and the motion carried. The vote was taken by ballot. Moderator Williams appointed Becky Glodo, Allen Plott and Holly Duckworth as counters. While vote counting was taking place, Moderator Williams asked for a motion to change the order of the agenda to include the Pastor Benevolence Fund offering. Terry Kern moved to add the Pastor Benevolence Fund offering to the agenda. Kerry Shipley seconded, and the motion carried. The offering was taken after Carl Dillow prayed.

The vote results were read by Moderator Williams. Zero votes were written for pursuit of a full-time director search, 14 votes were for the multi-leader model and 13 votes were for pursuing a part-time director. Because of the extreme closeness of the votes, Clint Nale moved to table the vote until the May Executive Board meeting to give time for the Board members to seek the Lord and pray. Carl Dillow seconded. The motion carried.

In Miscellaneous business, it was announced that the Associational Leadership Council voted to change the date of the VBS Clinic from April 12 to April 5.

The written record of the January 14, 2025, meeting was approved as printed. The motion to accept the financial reports for the months of January – February 2025 carried.

### **May 13, 2025**

Moderator Darry Williams called the Executive Board of the Clear Creek Baptist Association to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the association building with twenty-three members representing seventeen churches and two guests present.

Executive Director Search Team Chairman Terry Kern explained the proposed new Executive Leadership Team Model to the Board and brought a recommendation that stated – “The Clear Creek Baptist Association Executive Director Search Team moves that the Executive Board adopt the Executive Leadership Team model and allow the association to move forward in finding leaders to fill these positions.” There was much discussion about specifics to this motion. After the discussion was complete, a vote by ballot was carried out. Moderator Williams appointed Dennie Hinkle, Elsie Hinkle and Judy Shoemaker as ballot counters. Moderator Williams read the results of the vote which was 20 yes votes and 3 no votes. The motion from the search team was approved.

The written record of the March 11, 2025, meeting was approved as printed. The motion to accept the financial reports for the months of March – April 2025 carried.

### **July 8, 2025**

Moderator Darryl Williams called the Executive Board of the Clear Creek Baptist Association to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the association building with twenty-three members representing fifteen churches and one guest present.

Representing the Nominating Team, Roger Stewart moved that Chuck Goforth be recommended to fill the vacancy on the Constitution Team, replacing Jim Haney, at least until the recommendations made at the Annual Meeting. The motion carried.

Executive Director Search Team Chairman Terry Kern gave an update from the team as follows:

“We wanted to clarify that the leadership model voted in at the last meeting is broken into 3 separate areas but at this time there is only a need to fill 2 positions (the Pastoral Care and Missions leaders). This is because the administrative duties are currently handled full time by Shelly.” There was time for questions.

“We are pausing the process of searching for both the Pastoral Care and Missions Leaders. This is because it has come to our attention that the associational constitution in its current state does not allow us to proceed with this search. The constitution must be amended and adopted before we can proceed with implementation of the shared leadership model. Our hope is that this could be completed and presented for consideration at the October 2025 Annual Meeting and then voted on at the 2026 Annual Meeting. Once the constitution is amended to reflect the shared leadership model, the personnel and nominating committees can proceed with filling the proposed leadership positions.” A few questions were raised on this subject,

“Based on this information, the search team feels it would be prudent to seek an interim director to help with the transition to the new model as well as assist with regular operations. We are asking that anyone interested in serving as interim submit a letter of interest prior to 8/1/25. Lord willing, we plan to present a recommendation for the selected interim at the September Executive Board meeting.” Questions were raised about pay and having positions ready to vote on at the annual meeting in 2026.

The written record of the May 13, 2025, meeting was approved as printed. The motion to accept the financial reports for the months of May – June 2025 carried.

### **September 9, 2025**

Moderator Darryl Williams called the Executive Board of the Clear Creek Baptist Association to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the association building with seventeen members representing twelve churches attending the meeting.

Melissa Dirden, representing the Associational Leadership Council, moved to change the November 11 Executive Board meeting to November 18. No second needed. The motion carried.

Executive Director Search Team Chairman Terry Kern read a motion that stated the following, “The Clear Creek Baptist Association Executive Director Search Team, along with the Personnel and Stewardship Teams, moves that the Executive Board employ Clint Nale as interim Executive Director during the transition to a new team model, effective September 15, 2025, through the completion of the 2026 annual meeting with a recommended salary of \$300 per week.” Clint asked to address the Board with his objectives before the vote. There were no questions. Vote by ballot was taken. Becky Glodo and Kerry Hill were appointed as vote counters. The vote was unanimous. As the vote and motion carried, the Executive Director Search Team was officially dissolved.

Executive Director Search Team Chairman Terry Kern gave a report on the team’s progress in finding a new Executive Director.

The written record of the July 8, 2025, meeting was approved as printed. The motion to accept the financial reports for the months of July – August 2025 carried.

## KINGDOM BUILDERS TEAM

The Kingdom Builders Team is responsible for cooperating with the Executive Director to disburse funds from the Kingdom Builders Earnings Fund through the Associational Treasurer in accordance with the following emphases:

## IBSA Partnership Report • Fall 2025

The Illinois Baptist State Association continues to provide network value to its nearly 900 cooperating churches through the strategies of health, growth, and mission. These strategies are resulting in ongoing signs of gospel advancement across our home-state mission field. Here are a few highlights from the first 7 months of 2025.

**Investing in the health of churches:** IBSA's Health Team is engaged with more than **90 pastors** in "revitalization readiness" coaching, and is leading more than **100 churches** through in-depth revitalization processes. Now in its fifth full year, IBSA's revitalization strategy is leading to healthier churches statewide. The number responding that revitalization is needed "now" or "urgently" in the Annual Church Needs survey continues to decrease (42% in 2024 down from 67% in 2019).

**Growing church leaders and training volunteers:** IBSA's Growth Team has hosted almost **500 participants** in leadership development events and provided ministry skills training to over **1,800 participants** from churches across the state. The annual Priority Women's Conference saw **647 women** attend to receive two days of leadership development and inspiration. IBSA also continues to support local Baptist associations. The two-day Associational Leaders Roundtable in Springfield hosted **45 Associational Mission Strategists, Moderators, and their spouses** for support and learning.

**Moving churches into mission:** This year, Illinois Baptist Disaster Relief has deployed trained volunteers to **23 different locations**, providing **10,630 hours of labor** to people in need. Beyond providing essential physical help, volunteers engaged in **131 gospel conversations**, distributed **274 Bibles**, and prayed with **3 people** to receive Christ. Over 80 churches have engaged in evangelism strategies through IBSA-hosted Ignite events and church evangelism consultations. **11 new churches** have been planted or restarted this year, with more projected this fall.

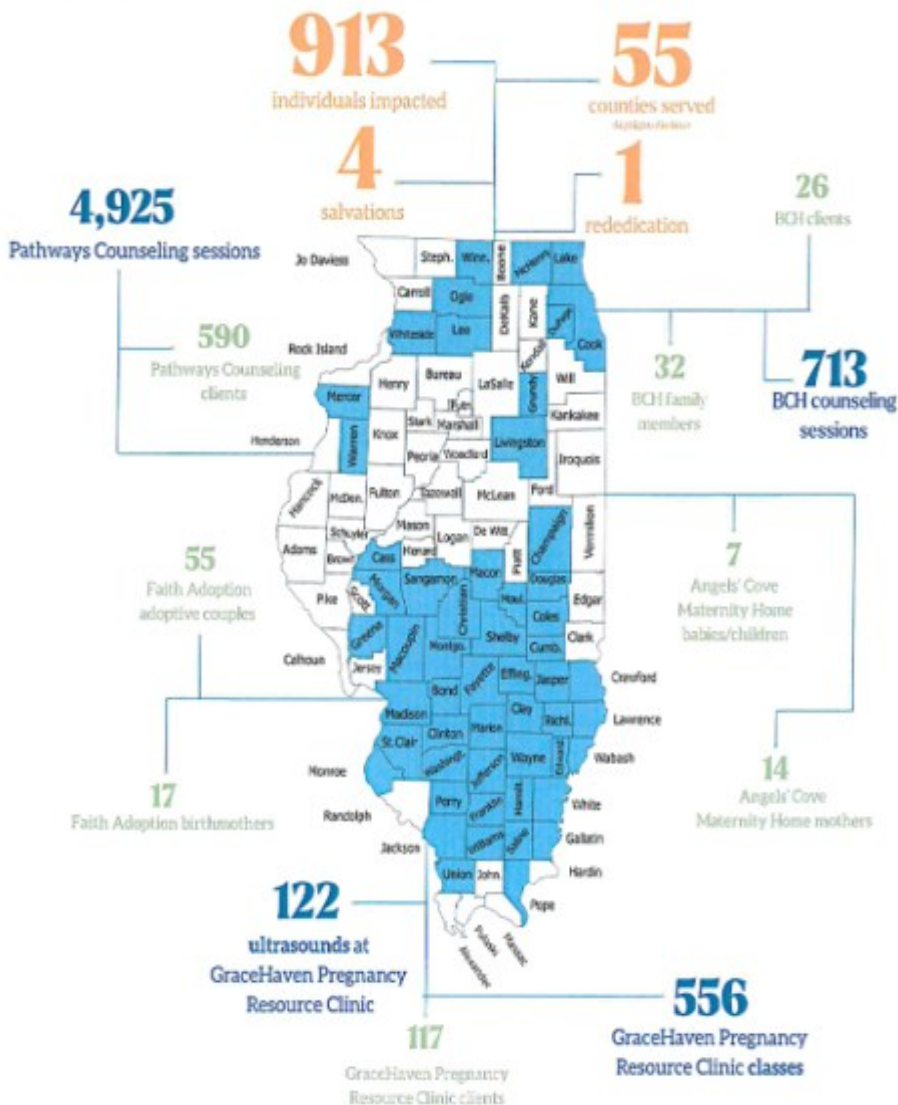
**Reaching the next generation:** At summer's end, more than **1,100 children and students** participated in IBSA camps at Lake Sallateeska and Streator Baptist Camps, surpassing the record high from 2019. **185 students** experienced intensive discipleship at Illinois Super Summer in June. Nearly **1,000 more students** are expected at Youth Evangelism Conference and AWSOM events this fall. Collegiate campus ministry is undergoing a strategic renewal, including significant maintenance and renovation updates at the SIU-Carbondale ministry facility.

Mid-year reports, combined with positive trends from the **Annual Church Profile (ACP)**, published in March, provide an optimistic outlook for gospel advance through Illinois Baptist cooperative work:

- Baptisms continued to rise, up 8.8% from 2023 (3,657 vs. 3,361), with 12% more churches recording baptisms (490 vs 434).
- Professions of faith were up over 15% (3,331 vs. 2,882)
- Worship attendance statewide rose nearly 3% from the previous year (60,640 vs. 52,666).

These numbers build on similar positive trends from the previous two years. While there was much to celebrate, the most recent ACP also shows that challenges remain. There was a slight decline in the total number of cooperating churches/missions despite adding 11 new congregations in 2024. Church missions giving through the Cooperative Program (CP) was slightly up year-over-year (\$5,391,920 vs. \$5,338,046), but still more than 18% lower than the historic high of \$6,640,960 in 2009.

Thank you for your church's participation and cooperative giving. Together, IBSA churches and ministries are taking the gospel to the more than 8 million lost people in Illinois.

## Report to the Associations

**OUR MISSION:** Baptist Foundation of Illinois encourages Illinois Baptists to respond, both individually and corporately, to God's call of stewardship upon their lives, connecting them with ministry opportunities that transform the world with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

**LIFE STEWARDSHIP:** Our work in the area of Life Stewardship is the heart of everything we do at BFI. We continue to meet with several clients each week, helping them create a Christian Estate Plan that meets their individual needs. BFI's Christian Estate planning services are offered to Illinois Baptists at no cost. BFI has helped over 250 families design a plan that maximizes resources, avoids unnecessary taxes and probate, and provides for the people and ministries they love. This work will eventually result in \$50 million in gifts to Kingdom causes.

**SAVING & INVESTING:** BFI works tirelessly to provide Illinois Baptist churches and individuals with saving and investing options that provide a competitive rate of return while minimizing risk. With the market uncertainty over the past couple of years, we have observed an increased demand for fixed rate investments, such as our BFI Bonds. BFI Bonds are sold in \$1,000 increments and support church capital loans. In 2024, we raised our bond rates to 5.00% for all maturities. In August of 2025, we raised our Cash Management rates from 2.25% to 3.75%.

**EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS:** In 2024, BFI awarded \$85,200 in educational scholarship support to 42 Illinois Baptist students (18 seminary and 24 undergraduate). During the Fall meeting, BFI's Board of Trustees voted to increase scholarship amounts beginning with the 2025 scholarship cycle. Seminary scholarships were increased from \$2,625 to \$7,500. Bachelor's scholarships went from \$2,000 to \$5,000, and associate's scholarships were increased from \$1,000 to \$2,000. In 2025, BFI will provide \$97,250 to 24 students (8 seminary and 16 undergraduate).

*Since 2015, BFI has awarded 416 scholarships totaling \$914,825.*
